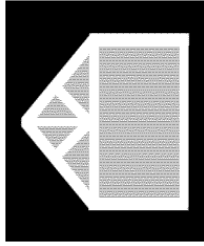
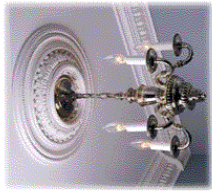

ISKCON Ireland's Next Big Step



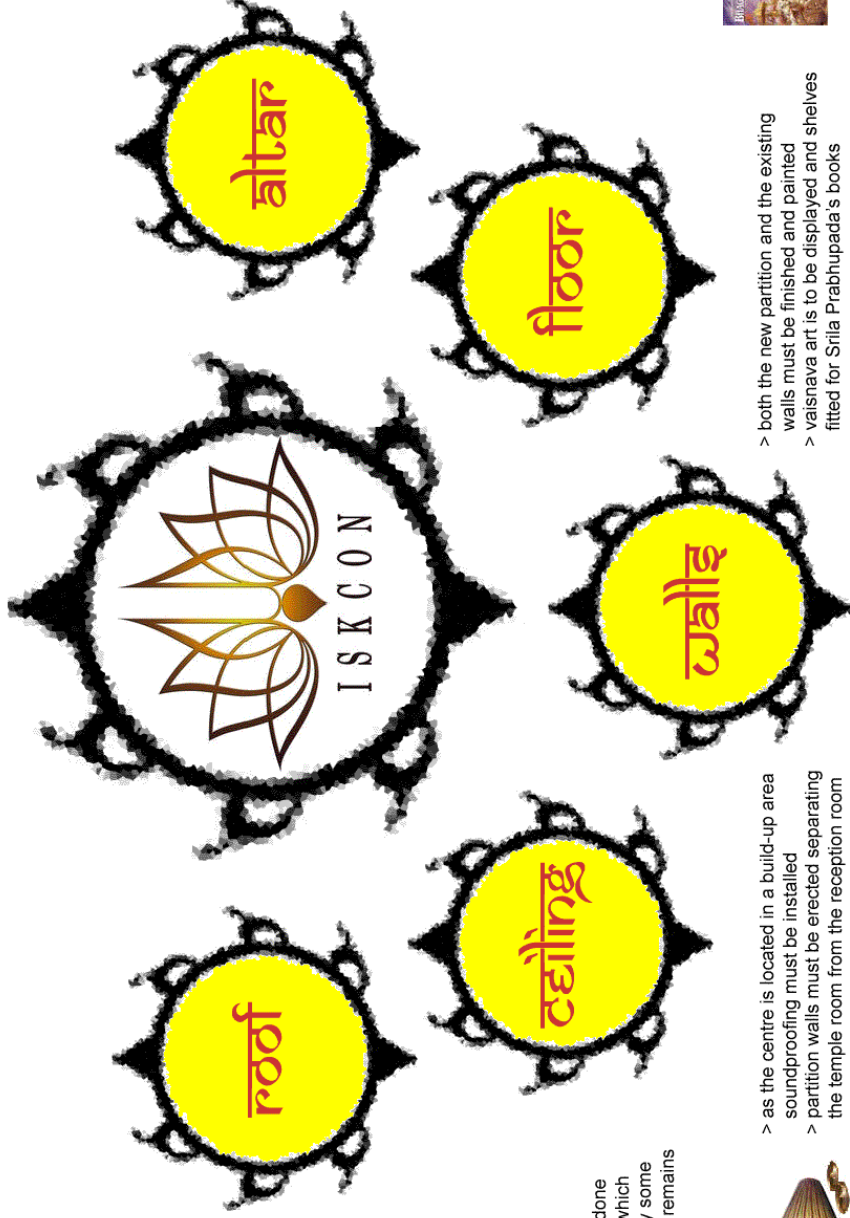
> the roof of the centre is leaking and must be fixed as soon as possible
